We notice that the <u>Mandalay Station cooling water pumps</u> and canal connecting the CI Harbor to the Mandalay Power Station are to be abandoned!

Since the 1970's, the Mandalay Station cooling water pumps provide an essential function to purge and prevent stagnation of <mark>Ventura County's Channel Island Harbor</mark>. The average flow is 10 million / gal / day (from 2010 to 2014) (design capacity is ~ 250 million gallons/day).

To abandon this system will quite possibly create a stagnant pond at the north-end of our Harbor!
