# ASBS Special Protections Storm Water and Nonpoint Source Discharges Scoping Meeting

## Outline of Comments and Suggestions August 1, 2006 Meeting

#### • Special Protections - General

- Clarify discharge types (e.g. different discharges that would/would not be allowed).
- Alternative: Strike "firefighting", potential violation portion of emergency procedures.
- Alternative: Inadequate maintenance not an excuse for an emergency.
- Evaluate existing Phase 1 & 2 CalTrans list.
- Comment: Vessel waste associated with hulls (paint, etc).
- Alternative: Upstream discharges covered by special protections.
- Alternative: Allow new outfalls if they do not contribute to waste discharge.

#### Special Protections – Enforcement

- Comment: How does Crystal Cove apply?
- Clarify enforcement process (State and Regional Boards).
- Comments: State Board to send a letter to dischargers informing them that their packages have been completed.
- Alternative: Drop requirement of justification for not submitting application in a timely matter.

#### Monitoring

- Alternative: Adaptive monitoring during the first five years for cost effectiveness.
- Comment: Consistency in data collection.
- Comment: Partial/non participation in monitoring programs.
- Alternative: Drop natural water quality in lieu of California Ocean Plan Table B.
- Address variability in storm water related to natural water quality.
- Alternative: Drop natural water quality in lieu of California Ocean Plan Table C.
- Comment: Use caution in determining reference site.
- Comment: Clarify natural water quality definition and Table B.
- Comment: Strengthen potential for statewide monitoring reference conditions.

#### Time Schedule Order

- Clarify term "order."
- Alternative: Time schedule for compliance.

### • Storm Water Management Plan

- Alternative: Address time schedule order for nonpoint source.

- Alternative: Performance standard must be met and include proof of interim progress, though the progress should not be based on individual discharges.
- Alternative: Flexibility in time schedule order deadline.

#### • Additional Comments

- Include as nonpoint source silver culture.
- Include process for Regional Board notification for those not otherwise notified.
- Priority on impaired ASBS.
- Include economics of monitoring (cost).
- Evaluate effects of monitoring on reference streams.
- Include blue ribbon panel merits report.
- Define criteria for determining reference creek, including consideration of impaired water bodies.
- Alternative: Include definitions page with the document.
- Alternative: Include graphic to help with definitions.
