

**STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD
ORDER WQ 2020-00XX-DWQ**

**RESCISSION OF ORDER WQ 2009-0006-DWQ
GENERAL WASTE DISCHARGE REQUIREMENTS FOR LANDSCAPE
IRRIGATION USES OF MUNICIPAL RECYCLED WATER**

The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) finds that:

1. On or before July 31, 2009, Water Code section 13552.5 (a)(1) required the State Water Board to adopt a general permit for landscape irrigation uses of recycled water for which the California Department of Public Health had established uniform water recycling criteria pursuant to Water Code section 13521.
2. On July 7, 2009, the State Water Board adopted Order WQ 2009-0006-DWQ in compliance with the statutory requirement of Water Code section 13552.5(a)(1).
3. On June 7, 2016, the State Water Board adopted Water Reclamation Requirements for Recycled Water Use, Order WQ 2016-0068-DDW. This Order covers the same subject and requirements for landscape irrigation uses of recycled water that are included in Order WQ 2009-0006-DWQ and covers additional non-potable uses.
4. Order WQ 2016-0068-DDW meets the statutory requirements of Water Code section 13552.5. Therefore, Order WQ 2009-0006-DWQ is now redundant and may be rescinded. Order WQ 2009-0006-DWQ has no current enrollees.
5. This action in no way prevents the State Water Board and Regional Water Quality Control Boards from taking enforcement action for past violations of Order WQ 2009-0006-DWQ.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Order WQ 2009-0006-DWQ is rescinded, with an effective date of March 20, 2021, except for enforcement purposes.
