The comment is that the Certified Professional of Storm Water Quality (CPSWQ) from CASQA should be an adequate underlying credential for certification.

This certification is used industry wide for developing monitoring and sampling plans and certainly demonstrates competency to write Industrial SWPPPs to a level at or above a landscape architect, which in the draft is currently approved for certification.

And, by way of disclosure, I personally am not a CPSWQ.
