NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING, OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT, AND ADOPTION MEETING

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO GENERAL PERMIT FOR STORM WATER DISCHARGES FROM SMALL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEMS (MS4) (IMPLEMENTING REGION-SPECIFIC TOTAL MAXIMUM DAILY LOAD REQUIREMENTS)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will receive public comment on the proposed amendment to the General Permit for Storm Water Discharges from Small MS4s (Small MS4 General Permit). The proposed amendment to the existing Small MS4 General Permit addresses the implementation of 73 Total Maximum Daily Loads (TMDLs).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The State Water Board adopted the Small MS4 General Permit (Order 2013-0001-DWQ) on February 5, 2013. Through sections E.15.c and F.5.i.3 of the Small MS4 General Permit, the State Water Board directed the Regional Water Quality Control Boards (Regional Water Boards) to review Attachment G –Region-Specific Requirements, and propose revisions to implement existing TMDL requirements. State Water Board staff developed the proposed amendment based on Regional Water Board staff recommendations and small MS4 permittee feedback. The proposed amendment revises the TMDL implementation requirements in Attachment G and modifies the corresponding Findings, Provisions, and Fact Sheet of the Small MS4 General Permit accordingly. The proposed amendment additionally makes a revision to the annual reporting program to add a due date for submission of the annual reports.

SCOPE OF PROPOSED AMENDMENT AND PUBLIC COMMENTS

This Notice provides a 45-day public review period of the proposed amendment. The Public Hearing scheduled above is within the public comment period, allowing interested parties the opportunity to provide oral comments to the State Water Board in addition to written comments.

Public comments in response to this Notice must be limited to the proposed revisions in the following portions of the existing Small MS4 General Permit:

- (1) Finding 40,
- (2) Section E.13.b. TMDL Monitoring,
- (3) Section E.15. Total Maximum Daily Loads Compliance Requirements,
- (4) Section E.16.a. Annual Reporting Program,
- (5) Section F.5.i. Total Maximum Daily Loads Compliance Requirements,
- (6) Section F.5.j.2. Online Annual Reporting,
- (7) The Fact Sheet, and
- (8) Attachment G Region-specific TMDL Requirements

The State Water Board will not consider public comments outside the scope of the proposed amendment. The State Water Board is not required to respond to public comments on issues raised outside the scope of the proposed amendment.
