NOTICE OF PUBLIC WORKSHOP AND NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

MUNICIPAL STORM WATER PERMITS RECEIVING WATER LIMITATIONS LANGUAGE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) will hold a public workshop concerning the receiving water limitations provisions (Receiving Water Limitations Language) of National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permits for storm water discharges from Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4s). The public workshop will be held as follows:

A quorum of State Water Board members may be present at the workshop. The Board members may provide direction to staff, but no final action will be taken until a subsequent, noticed Board meeting.

The State Water Board is soliciting written public comments on an issue paper discussing several alternatives that may be considered by the Board in addressing the Receiving Water Limitations Language (Issue Paper). Interested persons must submit all written comments no later than 12:00 noon on Tuesday, November 13, 2012.

BACKGROUND

The current Receiving Water Limitations Language in NPDES permits for MS4s issued by the State Water Board and the regional water quality control boards is derived from precedential State Water Board Orders WQ 2001-15 and 99-05.

The purpose of the public workshop is for the State Water Board to hear stakeholder concerns with the current Receiving Water Limitations Language in light of the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeal's decision in NRDC v. County of Los Angeles (9th Cir. 2011) 673 F.3d 880 and to solicit recommendations on whether and how to modify the language in MS4 permits.

The State Water Board will circulate a detailed agenda prior to the meeting. At the public workshop, participants will be given an opportunity to make oral statements. Participants are encouraged to submit written comments by the deadline above and may summarize those comments orally at the public workshop. To ensure a productive and efficient public meeting in which all participants have an opportunity to participate, oral statements may be time-limited.

EX PARTE COMMUNICATIONS

At the State Water Board's December 4/5, 2012, meeting, the Board anticipates adoption of an NPDES permit for small MS4s. While the small MS4 permit is pending before the State Water Board, issues in that proceeding are subject to a prohibition on ex parte communications to the State Water Board members. The receiving water limitations language is an issue in the small MS4 proceeding. Other than written comment letters submitted in accordance with this notice or any notice on the small MS4 proceeding, and oral comments during the receiving water limitations workshop or small MS4 meeting, interested persons may not communicate directly to State Water Board members about the receiving water limitations language while the small MS4 permit is pending.
