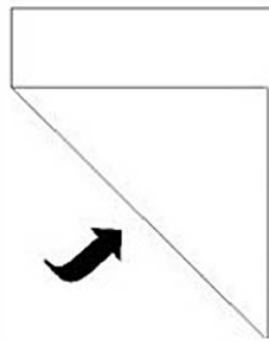




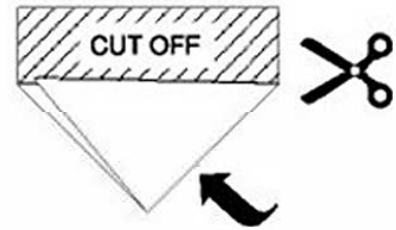
THE CLEAN WATER TEAM WATERBODY FACT CATCHER



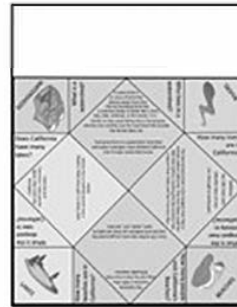
1. Print your "Waterbody Fact Catcher".



2a. Fold a corner up so that it meets the other side. Next fold the other corner up until it meets the other side, then cut off the rectangle at the top.

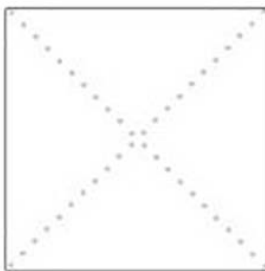


or 2b. Cut the printed square out using a paper trimmer.

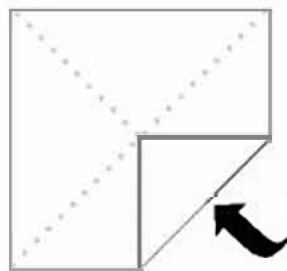


or 2c. Cut the printed square out with scissors or cutter

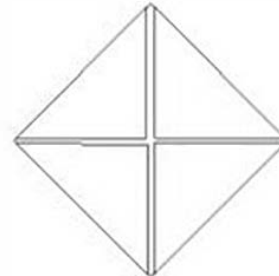

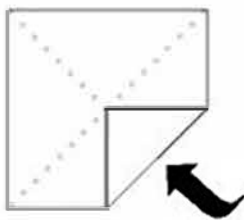
3. Unfold it and place it printed side down.



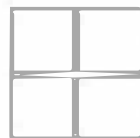
4. Fold up all four corners so that all the points meet in the middle.



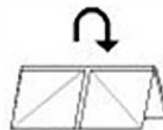
5. It should look like this. Flip it over.



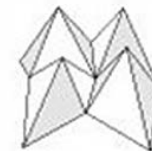
6. Fold up all four corners so that they meet in the middle.



7. It should now look like this.



8. Now fold the top back.



9. Work your fingers into the four corners from the fold side, work the creases to form four points.

RIVERS



Who lives in a watershed?

A watershed is an area of land that directs water from the surrounding land into a common body of water like a river, bay, lake, wetland, or the ocean. It is similar to how sand falling into a funnel goes directly into a bottle, but the sand that falls outside the funnel does not.

How many rivers are in California?

California has 185 rivers and 189,454 miles of river run through its landscapes.

The Sacramento River is the longest river that is entirely within California. This river flows south for 400 miles before reaching the Sacramento-San Joaquin River Delta and San Francisco Bay.

Everyone lives in a watershed. Scientists and water managers have divided California into 9 major watershed areas.

Does California have many lakes?

California has more than 3,000 named lakes, reservoirs, and dry lakes.

Lake Tahoe is 1,645 feet deep, making it the second-deepest in the United States.
