





Types of fish surveys



Basic Resource Assessment—Fish Community Composition Presence/Absence Abundance estimates, indexes, trends Status of threatened/endangered species







Direct Observation—snorkel survey





California Wild Trout Program

- Established in 1971
- Designate streams and lakes to be managed for wild trout and quality angling
- Recommend special angling regulations
- Monitor sport fisheries and fish populations

Trout and Steelhead Conservation and Management Planning Act of 1979

- Conduct statewide inventory of trout streams and lakes
- Recommend "Catch-and-Release" angling regulations annually
- Evaluate "Catch-and-Release" angling regulations
