It looks like my data started in May while what you had started in Jan of the same year so that explains part of the issue. Also I saw some geomeans that should be recalculated. When we are ready to send up the admin record to State Board I will put in our transmittal letter a request to re-examine the single sample and geomean data for San Clemente Pier.
