

**COMMENT LETTER 100 - TROUT UNLIMITED OF CALIFORNIA, STAN GRIFFIN
(OCTOBER 7, 1996), RECEIVED OCTOBER 7, 1996**

Response to Comment 100-1

Comment Summary: This comment expresses concern that River disposal Alternatives 5 A&B will cause long term cumulative adverse impacts on the Russian River anadromous fishery.

Draft EIR/EIS conclusions which address whether salmon and steelhead in Santa Rosa Creek and Mark West Creek are affected by Project alternatives are summarized in Responses to Comments 85-326 and 85-401. The Russian River also contains many other salmonid subpopulations which return to other tributaries and to the Dry Creek hatchery. The EIR/EIS authors made no studies of these, but made an educated judgment that they will be exposed to much lower Santa Rosa reclaimed water concentrations than those fish which return to Santa Rosa Creek and Mark West Creek.
