Comment on Wastewater EIR/EIS

As originator of the Seal Watch program, developed to protect the harbor seal population at the mouth of the Russian River, I have serious concerns regarding the use of the river as the major wastewater disposal option. Especially concerning are the figures for cyanide residue. Pollution studies on the resident harbor seal population in San Francisco Bay are highly disturbing. I urge a more comprehensive look at this marine mammal population - the largest on this coast north of Point Reyes - and the unknown impact of a twenty percent discharge on their well-being. Serious violations of the federal Marine Mammal Protection Act may occur with a discharge of this size.
