

COMMENTS ON THE WASTEWATER EIR/EIS S.R.

The wastewater problem should be solved through using less water. 001  
Presently, there is a horrendous waste of water. If we used less,  
there would be less waste.

ALTERNATIVE No. 1. Doing nothing. It has some good points because it 002  
eventually leads to the North Coast Regional Water Quality Control  
Board not allowing more sewer hookups and this would limit the growth  
of the area.

ALTERNATIVE No. 2. South County reclamation. Within Alternative 2. 003  
there are four subsections. We strongly oppose 2A, the Tolay Extended  
Reservoir. It would destroy 456 acres of farmland, 158 acres of  
grazing land, 248 acres of wetlands and all do unacceptable environ-  
mental damage.

ALTERNATIVE No. 3. West County reclamation. We strongly oppose this 004  
alternative. Two Rock wastewater reservoir (3A) is not acceptable. All  
the huge wastewater lakes in an area where the farmers do not want  
this irrigation water and the huge dams needed for the storage in an  
earthquake area are all reasons enough not to go this route. Alter-  
native 3 has the most opposition, because of the potential for immense  
environmental damage. No on 3.

ALTERNATIVE 4. Injection into the Geysers is unacceptable. This is 005  
a crazy idea.

ALTERNATIVE 5. Discharge into the Russian River is unacceptable since 006  
the discharged wastewater is not cleaned up enough.
