- ② 1.9 The draft eir/eis may be purchased on C.D. Rom for 120.00 The only problem is there are two 002
books missing. Therefore all information was not made available to the public. Also the Tax
payers already paid for the study to begin with. The report was only available at a few
libraries and could not be checked out. Most people work for a living and library hours are
not always convenient.
- ③ 1.8 EIR/EIS time line your graph shows your time from June 1994 to 8/7/96 to prepare the 003
document. The property owners on the other hand only had from August 1996 to October to read
17 volumes (minus 2) consider the consequences and respond. People in the west county had to
drive quite a distance just to get access to the books. What if they had the time and if
someone else was already looking at the books.
- ④ We hear that Santa Rosa's water is almost drinkable. Yet it is known that disease causing organ 004
isms can survive the filtration process. S.R. measures the most probable number of Coliforms,
only one of three of the chlorine contact chambers to determine if Pathogens have survived the
process. These standards allow for considerable risk. Exposure to even tertiary effluent can
cause disease and diluted effluent is not safe either.
- ⑤ Last but not least our West County wells are shallow 20 to 40 feet deep just how long will 005
it take to contaminate our CLEAN CLEAR COOL DRINKING WATER WEST COUNTY PAYS AGRICULTURAL
IRRIGATION AND TREATMENT PLANTS ARE UNACCEPTABLE.
- ⑥ The idea that Santa Rosa can consider the prospect of condoning 19 400 Acres of West County 006
land change the Environment and alter our most fragile EOC SYSTEM is unconscionable.
We have heard that there are people that want this waste water north of Santa Rosa let them
have it we DON'T want it. Remember the other disastrous accidents that occurred because we
went against the Laws of Nature.
