Commingled Plume Account (CPA)

The Commingled Plume Account (CPA) Program was created in 1997 to assist and encourage responsible parties in coordinating cleanup efforts of groundwater contamination from more than one unauthorized petroleum release that has created a commingled plume. A commingled plume occurs when two or more separate unauthorized petroleum releases have mixed or encroached upon one another to the extent that the corrective action performed on one plume will necessarily affect the other. The CPA Program is a subaccount under the Underground Storage Tank Cleanup Fund Program and receives an annual \$10 million appropriation. Any unused funds remaining in a fiscal year can be used for other general Underground Storage Tank claims.

CPA Program Status

- A total of 53 Letters of Commitment have been issued to eligible claimants.
- 27 claims have been closed to date, while 26 claims remain active.
- More than \$116 million has been disbursed since the program's inception.
