To: Underground Storage Tank (UST) Cleanup Fund (Fund) Claimants

SUBJECT: UPLOADING OF SITE INFORMATION TO GEOTRACKER

Persons responsible for submitting reports and other specified data concerning underground storage tank (UST) sites are required by Water Code Sections 13195-13197.5 and UST Regulations Sections 3890-3895 to file that information electronically over the Internet in the State Water Board's GeoTracker system. UST Cleanup Fund (Fund) claimants are not in compliance with this requirement if they or their consultants have not uploaded the required site information into GeoTracker or if their site information is not up-to-date in GeoTracker. Claimants must remain in compliance with all laws and regulatory directives. If the Fund finds that you are out-of-compliance with the electronic reporting requirements, your claim will not be eligible to receive reimbursement until you resolve the matter.

The upload and maintenance of your site's information in GeoTracker assists Fund staff in providing accurate and timely reviews of your claim (i.e., application eligibility, reimbursement for corrective action work performed, etc.). If you are unable to upload site information into GeoTracker because your case has not been established within GeoTracker, please contact your regulatory agency to have one created.
