# Online Payments Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT) Payment

ACH Debit - The Automated Clearing House (ACH) Debit method allows the State Data Collector to electronically debit your bank account and credit the state's bank account. Your account will be debited by the state data collector only upon your initiation and for the amount you specify.

- The state pays the cost for you to make an ACH Debit payment via the First Data payment portal. You will be responsible for the fee, if any, that your financial institution may charge for the actual transfer of funds.
- Initiate an <u>ACH Debit transfer on the First Data website</u> (the application supports the Microsoft Internet Explorer, Chrome, Firefox and Safari browsers).



Information required to make a payment:

- Application, invoice, or loan number
- Bank routing number
- Bank account number

**Step 1:** Initiate an ACH Debit transfer by going to the First Data website

**Step 2:** Select "Application Fees" to access the payment site.




Step 3: "Payment Info" tab

- 1. The SWRCB Application Number will be "FA-" followed by the Form ID provided with the facility's enrollment via the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS).
- 2. The Invoice Amount is based on the tier your facility is in. You can find the appropriate fee on the State Water Resources Control Board's <u>Water Quality Fees webpage</u>.
- 3. Click Continue








## Step 4: "Contact Info" Tab

- 1. Enter the correct contact information for the payment.
- 2. Click Continue




## Step 5: "Payment Method" Tab

- 1. Enter the information as shown on the screen.
- 2. Click Continue








## Step 6: "Confirm Payment" Tab

- 1. Verify that the information on the screen is correct. Return to earlier steps to make corrections if necessary.
- 2. Click Submit Payment
  - Recommendation: keep a copy of the confirmation screen for your records.







ACH Credit - The ACH Credit method allows your financial institution to debit your account and credit the state's bank account. Your account will be debited by your financial institution upon your initiation and for the amount you specify.

- You will pay the fees charged by your financial institution for any set-up costs and for each ACH Credit transaction initiated.
- If you choose the ACH Credit method, please contact us at\_ <u>Receipts Unit@waterboards.ca.gov</u> or 916-341-5000. We will provide you with the State Water Resources Control Board's EFT bank account and routing number.
  - Note the underscore between Receipts and Unit

**Credit Cards** – The Official Payments Corporation payment system allows you to use a credit card to make a payment to the SWRCB.

Payments can be made by Visa, MasterCard, or Discover on the Official Payments Corporation website.

You will be responsible for paying the convenience fee that is charged by Official Payments when making a payment on their website. This fee is in addition to the amount owed to the State Water Resources Control Board.

**Step 1:** Make a payment by Visa, MasterCard, or Discover on the <u>Official Payments</u> Corporation website.

Step 2: Select "Make A Payment" under State Payments



#### **Step 3:** Make a Payment

- 1. State or Territory select California
- 2. Payment Entity select State Water Resources Control Board
- 3. Payment Type select Application Fees
- 4. Click on Make a Payment







#### Step 4: SWRCB Application Fee Types

- 1. Select "Waste Discharge Requirement (Non-15) Application" from the drop-down
- 2. Click Search



#### **Step 5:** Application Fees

- 1. The SWRCB Application Number will be "FA-" followed by the Form ID provided with the facility's enrollment via the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS).
  - a. The red x should turn into a green checkmark
- 2. The Invoice Amount is based on the tier your facility is in. You can find the appropriate fee on the State Water Resources Control Board's Water Quality Fees webpage.
- Click ADD
  - a. Note if you are submitting payment for more than one facility repeat the steps above for each one.




Step 6: View Cart

1. Once you have added your payment(s) to the cart, click View Cart.








#### Step 7: Verify

- 1. Verify that the items in your cart are correct. Remove or add items as necessary.
- 2. Click Continue




#### Step 8: Payment information

- 1. Enter the credit card payment information and complete the reCAPTCHA verification.
- 2. Click Continue







#### Step 9: Terms and Conditions

- 1. Read the Terms and Conditions.
- 2. Click Accept Terms



#### Step 10: Account Information

- 1. Enter the correct contact information for the payment.
- 2. Click Continue







#### Step 11: Submit Payment

- 1. Verify that the Account Information is correct. Return to earlier screens to correct if needed.
- 2. Click Submit
  - Recommendation: keep a copy of the confirmation screen for your records.







# **Mailed Payments Check, Money Order, or Cashier Check**

- Make the check, money order, or cashier check payable to the appropriate Regional Water Quality Control Board. Mailing address can be found in the table on the following page of this guidance document.
  - o If you need assistance determining which region your facility is in, visit the <u>Water</u> Boards map.
- Write "FA-" followed by the Form ID provided with the facility's enrollment via the California Integrated Water Quality System (CIWQS) on the check, money order, or cashier check (unless the winery has received an invoice number).
- Payments should be remitted to the address on the application, invoice, or loan payment voucher.
