Amount:	13,513 acre-feet by diversion to underground storage, at a maximum combined rate of 40.2 cubic feet per second
Season:	November 1 through April 30
Purpose of Use:	Irrigation and Municipal Use
Place of Use:	Within the boundaries of the City of Huron and 5,657 acres of irrigated agricultural land in Fresno County, as shown on maps filed with the State Board.
