## State Water Resources Control Board

### Notice of Water Right Application A032904

Duckhorn Wine Company has filed an application to appropriate water by permit with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights. The applicant is seeking a new water right to divert 10 acre-feet to storage in existing reservoir 1 located at the point of diversion during the period of April 1 through May 31 of each year. The amount of water being sought for the new water right permit would be limited such that the combined total amount diverted to storage in reservoir 1 each year under the water right issued pursuant to this application and under permit 19572 (application A028156) would not exceed 10 acre-feet. The project associated with the application is located in San Benito County and would divert water from the San Benito River stream system.

### Summary of Water Right Application A032904

**Date of Filing:** The application was filed with the State Water Board on February 8, 2018.

**Source of Water:** The source of water is Harlan Creek which is tributary to Indian Canyon thence Pescadero Creek thence the San Benito River.

**Amount:** The maximum amount of water requested for diversion is 10 acre-feet per year, which would be diverted by collection to onstream storage.

**Season of Diversion:** The season for diversion of water is from April 1 to May 31 of each year.

**Point of Diversion:** The point where water will be diverted is located at North 2,146,331 feet and East 5,862,734 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 4, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Southeast quarter of Section 23, Township 14 South, Range 5 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

**Purpose of Use:** The purpose of use for water is irrigation.

**Place of Use:** The place of use for water is 96 acres within sections 14, 23, and 24, all within Township 14 South, Range 5 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.
