NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE FOR PERMIT 20808B (APPLICATION 27614B)

COUNTY: Monterey

STREAM SYSTEM:

Carmel River

Monterey Peninsula Water Management District (MPWMD) has filed a petition for change, seeking to change San Clemente Dam from a Point of Rediversion (PORD) to a Point of Diversion (POD). MPWMD is also seeking to add two Points of Injection and Recovery (POIR) to the Seaside Groundwater Basin with a maximum rate of diversions of 8.0 cubic feet per second (cfs) and a maximum annual amount of 2,900 acre-feet (af). The groundwater basin will be a place of storage. Any correspondence regarding this matter should be sent to Monterey Peninsula Water Management District, c/o Darby Fuerst P.O. Summary of Permit

Source:	(1) Carmel River and (2) Carmel River (Subterranean Stream) tributary to the Pacific Ocean
Proposed POD and POIR :	POD (San Clemente Dam) is located within the NW ¹ / ₄ of SW ¹ / ₄ of projected Section 24, T17S, R2E, MDB&M. POIR 1 (ASR #3) and POIR 2 (ASR #4) are located within the SE ¹ / ₄ of SE ¹ / ₄ of projected Section 14, T15S, R1E, MDB&M.
Amount:	42 cfs by direct diversion and 21,574 af per annum by storage. Total amount of water to be taken from the source shall not exceed 26,574 af per water year October 1 to September 30 of the succeeding year.
Season:	Diversion season of November 1 of each year to June 30 of the succeeding year.
Purpose of Use:	Municipal, irrigation, and fish and wildlife preservation and ehhancement.
Place of Use:	110,000 acres within the boundaries of the MPWMD.
