

## PETITION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

Application 023925 Permit 19216

Water Code section 1396 requires an applicant to exercise due diligence in developing a water supply for beneficial use. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), in considering requests for extension of time, will review the facts presented to determine whether there is good cause for granting an extension of time to complete the project. Where diligence in completing the project is not fully substantiated, the State Water Board may set the matter for hearing to determine the facts upon which to base formal action relating to the permit. Formal action may involve:

1. Revoking the permit for failure to proceed with due diligence in completing the project.
2. Issuing a license for the amount of water heretofore placed to beneficial use under the terms of the permit.
3. Granting a reasonable extension of time to complete construction work and/or full beneficial use of water.

Attachment #1

1. Project Description

This project consists of the direct diversion of water from Mill Creek for domestic purposes within the Lake Pillsbury Ranch Subdivision. The diversion facility and water distribution system is complete and no further development is required. Water is also used for stockwatering purposes.

The subdivision also receives water diverted pursuant to License 314 (Application 2039) and Statement of Water Diversion and Use 8123. Water has been diverted for domestic uses on lands within the subdivision since the early 1900's.

The Subdivision consists of a total of 359 lots. Currently there are 134 connections using water. An additional 225 lots have been fully plumbed with turnouts and meter boxes but have not yet been improved. The full amount of water authorized under Permit 19216 is not expected to be used prior to improvement of all lots, which is projected to occur by 2030.
