## NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE FOR PERMIT 7643 (APPLICATION 7482)

COUNTY: Imperial STREAM SYSTEM: Colorado River

Imperial Irrigation District and San Diego County Water Authority (SDCWA) have filed a joint petition for change, related to changing the conditions of Revised WRO 2002-0013. The order approved a 75-year transfer of conserved water to SDCWA, Coachella Valley Water District, Improvement District No. 1 and Metropolitan Water District subject to implementation of the Salton Sea Habitat Conservation Strategy for a period of 15 years from the date of execution of the Quantification Settlement Agreement.

The petition requests to eliminate the obligation to provide mitigation water to the Salton Sea from 2014 through 2017, unless by that time a Salton Sea restoration project has been validly adopted by the California Legislature or the federal government and funded, which affects the timing of transfers. In lieu of this requirement, the petition proposes to establish alternative habitat for Salton Sea wildlife and other resources. Also, the petition requests to eliminate the previous requirement for construction of brown pelican roosting structures in the Pacific Ocean.
