### NOTICE OF PETITION FOR CHANGE OF PLACE OF USE AND PURPOSE OF USE TO DEDICATE WATER FOR THE PRESERVATION AND ENHANCEMENT OF FISH AND WILDLIFE RESOURCES FOR PRE-1914 WATER RIGHT CLAIM (STATEMENT 15372)

COUNTY: SISKIYOU

STREAM SYSTEM: KLAMATH RIVER

PacifiCorp has filed a change petition, pursuant to Water Code section 1707, with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division). The petition requests to:

- Add 1.6 instream miles of Fall Creek as an authorized place of use; and
- Add Fish and Wildlife Preservation and Enhancement as a beneficial use.
