Notice of Petition for Change for Water Right Permit 501 (Application A000448)

The Grenada Irrigation District has filed petition for change of a water right permit with the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights. The permit is referenced as Diversion Number 249 in paragraph 149 of Decree No. 7035 issued by the Siskiyou County Superior Court on December 30, 1932 (Shasta River Decree). The project associated with the petition is in Siskiyou County and diverts water from the Shasta River stream system.

The petition is part of a group of petitions that have been filed as part of a Safe Harbor Agreement process being coordinated with the National Marine Fisheries Service and the California Department of Fish and Wildlife. Collectively, the proposed actions described in the petitions are intended to improve fish habitat conditions in the upper Shasta River watershed.

Summary of Water Right Permit 501 and Proposed Changes

Source of Water: The source of water is the Shasta River, which is tributary to the Klamath River.

Amount: The maximum amount of water that may be directly diverted is 40 cubic feet per second.

Season of Diversion: The season for diversion of water is between April 1 and October 1 of each year.

Point of Diversion: The point where water is diverted is located at North 2,469,884 feet and East 6,431,760 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 1, North American Datum 1983, within the Northwest quarter of the Northwest quarter of Section 6, Township 43 North, Range 5 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian. This point is also known as Shasta River Decree point of diversion 249.

The petition does not propose a change to the point of diversion.

Purpose of Use: The purpose of use for water is irrigation.

The petition proposes to add fish and wildlife preservation and enhancement in a portion of the Shasta River as a purpose of use.

Place of Use: The place of use for water is 4,177 acres for irrigation within the Grenada Irrigation District service area.

The petition proposes to add a portion of the Shasta River for fish and wildlife preservation and enhancement use. The upstream limit would be a point on the Shasta River located at Shasta River Decree point of diversion 249. The downstream limit would be a point on the Shasta River located at North 2,494,277 feet and East 6,423,313 feet by California Coordinate System, Zone 1, North American Datum 1983, within the Northeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section 11, Township 44 North, Range 6 West, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian.

Protests must be received by the Division of Water Rights by **4:30 p.m.** on **August 27, 2021**, with copy provided to the petitioner.
