THIS IS TO CERTIFY, That Beclamation District Number 786 of Stockton.

ba — made proof to the satisfaction of the Division

of Water Resources of California of a right to the use of the waters of Helicium River, South Feels

Mokelume River, Petate Slough and San Joaquin River

tributary of San Jonquin River and Suisun Bay

for the purpose of **Agricul turn!**under Permit 1412 of the Division of Water Resources and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of California, the rules and regulations of the Division of Water Resources and the terms of the said permit; that the priority of the right herein confirmed dates from 3417 36, 1933;

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to the amount actually beneficially used for said purposes and shall not exceed seventy-one and fifty-cix hundred the (71.56) cubic feet per second from about March let to about Meventer let of each season. In case of rotation the equivalent of such continuous flow allowance for any thirty day period may be diverted in a shorter time if there he no interference with other vected rights.

The point of diversion of such water/minimize are movable points along the shere line of said Reclamation District No. 756 in projected Sections 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 13, 14, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 26 and 28, T 3 N, R 4 B, N.D.B.AM. as shown on a map filed with the Division of Mater Resources (then Division of Mater Resources) on July 28, 1922.

A description of the lands or the place where such water is put to beneficial use is as follows:

6006 acres within the boundaries of said Reclamation District No. 756 as shown on the said map filed July 28, 1922, above referred to, on Bouldin Island and being approximately within projected T 3 N, R 4 E, N.D.B.AN.

As there is a possibility that there will not be sufficient water in San Jeaquin River during the latter part of the irrigation season to satisfy all requirements, this license is issued subject to the express condition that the use hereunder may be regulated by the Division of Water Resources during such periods of water scarcity to the end that such use will not interfere with rights under prior applications.

The right to the diversion and use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the point of diversion herein specified and to the lands or place of use herein described.

This license is granted and said appropriator takes all rights herein mentioned subject to the terms and conditions set forth in Section 20 of Chapter 586, Statutes 1913, which is as follows:

conditions set forth in Section 20 of Chapter 386, Statutes 1913, which is as follows:

Sec. 20. All permits and licenses for the appropriation of water shall be under the terms and conditions of this act, and shall be effective for such time as the water actually appropriated under such permits and licenses shall actually be used for the useful and beneficial purpose for which and water was appropriated but no longer; and every such permit or license shall include the enumeration of conditions therein which in substance shall include all of the provisions of this section and likewise the statement that any appropriator of water, to whom said permit or license may be issued, shall take the same subject to ruch conditions therein expressed, provided, that if, at any time after the expiration of twenty years after the graining of a license, the state, or any city, city and country, municipal water district, irrigation district, lighting district or political subdivision of the state shall have the right to purchase the works and property can use district, irrigation district, lighting district or political subdivision of the state to desiring to purchase the works and property can use district, irrigation district, lighting district or political subdivision of the state so desiring to purchase and the works will over construct the permittee or licenses, or the hier, successors or assigns of said permit to licenses, has cessed to put said works and property can be successors or assigns of said permittee or licenses, has cessed to put said water to such useful or beneficial purpose for which the permit tor license was granted, or that the permittee or licenses, or the heirs, successors or assigns of said permittee or licenses, and called and open to further appropriation in a coordance with the terms of other sections, and declare the water to be unappropriated and open to further appropriation in the permit or license was granted, then and in the secand the conditions in the permit or licenses was granted or secur


