To accomplish this transfer, the following temporary changes in the Place of Use (POU) and points of rediversion under PCWA's MFP Water Right Permit 13856 are being requested by Petition to:

2) Allow for the consumptive use of Transfer Water within the EBMUD service area (Attachment C) consistent with current beneficial use designations.
