Point of Diversion:	<u>Capay Diversion Dam</u> : North 2,021,690 feet and East 6,537,478 feet, within the NE¼ of SE¼ of projected Section 16, T10N, R2W, MDB&M
Amount:	72,000 acre-feet by diversion to underground storage, at a maximum rate of 600 cubic feet per second
Season:	November 15 to April 30
Purpose of Use:	Irrigation
Place of Use:	Up to 100,000 acres of irrigated agricultural land within the Applicant's service area in Yolo County, as shown on map filed with the State Water Board (Map 3 of Attachment 1 of the application).

Pursuant to Water Code section 1428, the State Water Board may issue a temporary permit in advance of public notice. Consequently, a temporary permit may be issued on the application before the end of the noticing period.
