Dear Ms. Gaffney:

This law firm represents the United States Board of Water Commissioners for the Walker River and the Water Master/Chief Deputy Water Commissioner for the Walker River. Pursuant to Article V, Section 5.4 of the Administrative Rules and Regulations Regarding Change of Point of Diversion, Manner of Use or Place of Use of Water of the Walker River and its Tributaries and Regarding Compliance with California Fish and Game Code §5937 and Other Provisions of California Law as amended through June 3, 1996, the United States Board of Water Commissioners ("Board") provides the State Water Resources Control Board with the following comments and recommendations to the Petitions for Temporary Transfer and Change under Licenses 6000 and 9407 ("Change Applications") filed by the Walker River Irrigation District ("WRID") in accordance with your letter dated March 13, 2013:

1. The Change Applications request to temporarily add Fish and Wildlife Preservation and Enhancement as an additional purpose of use for the licenses and to temporarily add the West Walker River from Topaz Reservoir and the East Walker River from Bridgeport Reservoir to the confluences of the Walker River, thence the Walker River to and encompassing Walker Lake, as an additional place of use for the licenses. The Change Applications propose to temporarily transfer and change a total quantity of 25,000 acrefeet of stored water rights for release for instream flow dedications within a one year period. Pursuant to Paragraph XV of the Walker River Decree ("Decree"), the Board and/or the Water Master are charged with the duty of apportioning and distributing the waters of the Walker River, its forks and tributaries in the State of Nevada and in the State of California, including water for storage and stored water, in accordance with the provisions of the Decree. If the stored water is used for instream flow dedication and not irrigation purposes during the irrigation season, return flows from this water would not be available for the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner to use in his computation of total amount of water available to serve the vested rights under the Decree as required on page 4 of the Rules and Regulations for the Distribution of Water of the Walker River Stream

System Under the Provisions of Section 15 of Decree Case in Equity C-125, in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada, adopted September 3, 1953.

- 2. Pursuant to Paragraph VIII of the Decree, water is to be stored by WRID in Topaz and Bridgeport Reservoirs from November 1 to March 1 of each irrigation season. The Decree provides WRID "may distribute such water so stored in said reservoirs to the lands in the District entitled thereto, in accordance with their respective rights." Under WRID's rules and regulations (existing or proposed), the season for delivery of storage water shall begin on April 1 and end on October 31 of each year. The water left in the reservoirs at the end of the irrigation season is used during the next irrigation season. Each WRID storage water right holder has an equal right with every other storage water right holder to use the water in proportion to his apportionment of benefits. WRID's proposed temporary transfer and change will allow storage water to be used for instream purposes, not to lands in the District, within a one year period and not limited to the April 1- October 31 irrigation season. Release of storage water for instream purposes outside of the irrigation season does affect other legal users of storage water. WRID's proposed manner, time and place of use are inconsistent with certain explicit provisions of the Decree.
- 3. In previous change applications approved pursuant to the Decree, an Applicant was not able to call for its water approved by a change application until it could put the water to beneficial use. Pages 4-5 of the Rules and Regulations for the Distribution of Water of the Walker River Stream System Under the Provisions of Section 15 of Decree Case in Equity C-125, in the United States District Court for the District of Nevada, adopted September 3, 1953, provide: "If at any time the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner through investigation determines that any users' water is not being put to beneficial use, but is going to waste, he shall immediately refuse delivery of water to the said user, unless and until he is satisfied that the water when returned to the user will be put to beneficial use within the meaning of the Decree." It is not clear how WRID will ensure the storage water temporarily changed will be beneficially used for Fish and Wildlife Preservation and Enhancement since WRID cannot manage the conveyance of water from the Wabuska Gauge to Walker Lake. There is no provision to monitor that others will not use temporarily released storage water if a release occurs during the irrigation season. In addition, it should be noted that Paragraph I of the Decree as amended by the Court's Order for Entry of Amended Final Decree to Conform to Writ of Mandate Etc., dated April 24, 1940, forever enjoins and restrains the Defendants in the Decree action and all persons claiming by, through or under them, "from preventing or interfering with the natural flow of said quantities of water from the channels of the said stream and its said tributaries down to and upon said Indian Reservation."

- 4. The Decree provides in Paragraph VIII that water shall not be stored in the Topaz or Bridgeport Reservoirs so as to deprive the parties to the Decree including the Tribe and the United States of stock water or water for domestic purposes. The Change Applications cannot deprive the parties to the Decree including the Tribe and the United States of stock water or water for domestic purposes. In addition, historically there has been no issue of potential interference with or impacts to the Tribe's decreed water rights by other decreed water users because the Tribe's use of water is last on the system. The Change Application proposes a new broad manner of use with new places of use both upstream and downstream from the Tribe's use. Granting the Change Applications as filed affects the historical administration of the Decree. Currently, the Weir is the last ditch take-out, then the Stanley Ranch has a river pump prior to the Parker's Gage and Parker's Gage is the last measurement of water on the system. The Board's measurement of water to the Tribe occurs at the Parker's Gage (Wabuska Gage) at the lower end of Mason Valley per the 1953 Rules and Regulations.
- 5. While this issue may only ultimately be resolved by the Court, the Board wanted to bring it to the attention of WRID and the State Water Resources Control Board¹. The Decree as amended provides at page 73, lines 2-6: "... also for regulatory purposes, including a change of point of diversion or of the place of use of any water user, but no water shall be sold or delivered outside of the basin of the Walker River except that appurtenant to the lands of Mrs. J A. Conway and R.P. Conway referred to in the foregoing tabulation." (emphasis added.) This language in the Decree was derived from a stipulation of the parties entered into near the close of the hearing in order to shorten the time of the trial of the action. The language was part of the broader stipulation with respect to the water rights of the parties to this suit which were not determined by the Decree in the suit in Equity No. 731. Report of the Special Master, pages 8-11, In Equity Case No. C-125, filed December 30, 1932. Prior to this stipulation, all the defendants in the action except Sierra Pacific Power Company entered into a stipulation filed with the Court on March 2, 1932 for the purpose of settling and adjusting certain controversies concerning questions of fact involved in the action. The stipulation provided in part: "That excepting the adjudicated appropriation rights of Mrs. J.A. Conway and Richard P. Conway, the rights of the several appropriators and users of water who are parties hereto shall be restricted to application and use on lands within the particular water shed or basin of Walker River, East Walker River, West Walker River, respectively, and their respective tributaries where said water is now used." The Decree was entered to settle the rights of water users of the Walker River for irrigation of the lands of the parties to the suit. Comments made at the time by the attorneys for various parties acknowledged that there was no beneficial

use of water that went to Walker Lake. To the undersigned's knowledge, the Decree language which provides "but no water shall be sold or delivered outside of the basin of the Walker River" has never been construed by the Court. There may need to be a determination made by the Court with regard to this prohibition contained in the Decree.

- 6. Article VI, Section 6.1 of the Administrative Rules and Regulations Regarding Change of Point of Diversion, Manner of Use or Place of Use of Water of the Walker River and its Tributaries and Regarding Compliance with California Fish and Game Code §5937 and Other Provisions of California Law provides in part, that when an action has been filed in any court which may affect the allocation and distribution of waters of the Walker River, the agency may withhold for good cause shown any pending decision on a change application or compliance application until such court action is concluded. There is litigation pending which may affect the allocation and distribution of waters of the Walker River. The Board brings this provision of the Administrative Rules and Regulations to the attention of the State Water Resources Control Board but takes no position as to whether or not the State Water Resources Control Board should withhold action on the pending Change Applications pursuant to this provision.
- 7. Because the Decree was entered to settle the rights of water users of the Walker River for irrigation of the lands of the parties to the suit, the question arises whether a Decree holder can own water rights but not own any land or the place of use for which the water is to be placed to beneficial use. Again, this may be an issue for the Court to decide.

The United States Board of Water Commissioners appreciates the opportunity to present these comments to the State Water Resources Control Board. Enclosed are copies of the Walker River Decree, Amended Final Decree and the 1953 Rules and Regulations for your convenience.

The Special Master -1 thereupon prepared and submitted to the attorneys for the several 2 parties to the suit, a proposed report, findings of fact and con-3 clusions of law and decree, for the purpose of enabling correct-4 ions of descriptions and in other minor matters to be made. There-5 after the cause was, at the request of the attorneys for the sev-К eral parties, reopened for the presentation of further evidence 7 respecting other rights than those which had been determined in 8 the proposed decree and further hearings were had and evidence, Q 10 oral and documentary, presented. Thereafter the cause was further argued by counsel, corrections in and additions to the proposed 11 decree were made and the cause again submitted to the Special 12 Master. The Special Master thereupon made his report to the Court, 1.3 submitting proposed findings of fact, conclusions of law and de-14 cree. Upon failure of any owner of such ditch or canal to install such regulating, locking and measuring device on or before the first day of May, 1937, or at such earlier date as may be fixed or demanded by the Water Master, upon ten days' notice, or to maintain such regulating, locking or measuring device, the Water Master shall cut off the water from such ditch or canal until the same shall be so installed and maintained.

XV. The Court, whenever it shall deem it necessary, shall appoint a Water Master, who shall be charged with the duty of apportioning and distributing the waters of the Walker River, its forks and tributaries in the State of Nevada and in the State

of California, including water for storage and stored water, in accordance with the provisions of this decree. / The said Water Master shall serve until the further order of this Court and may be removed by the Court at any time. The suid natural flow of water of said stream and its said tributaries to be diverted therefrom at the points of diversion now used for such purpose by plaintiff or at such other points as may hereafter be selected by plaintiff for such diversion, either upon or above the Walker River Indian Reservation, provided, however, that any change in point or points of diversion sought to be made by the United States of America, to

RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF WATER OF THE WALKER HIVER STREAM SYSTEM UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 15 OF DECREE CASE IN EQUITY C-125, IN THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF MEVADA.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 15 of the Decree of the United States District Court for the District of Nevada, Case in Equity C-125, there is submitted herewith rules and regulations for the distribution of water thereunder.

For distribution purposes the river shall be divided into six divisions set out as follows:

Division No. 1. That area on the Main Walker River consisting of the Schurz Indian Reservation, and extending from Walker Lake to the Wabber Dam.

Division Mo. 2. That area consisting of lands served from the Main Walker River from the Yerington Weir to the confluence of the East and West Walker Rivers.

Division No. 3. That area consisting of lands served from the East Walker River from the confluence of the East and West Walker Rivers to Bridgeport Dam.

Division No. 4. That area consisting of lands served from the East Walker River and its tributaries above Bridgeport Dam, consisting principally of Bridgeport Valley.

Division No, 5. That area consisting of lands served from the West Walker River and its tributaries from the confluence of the East and West Walker Rivers to the Intake Canal for Topaz Reservoir.

Division No. 6. That area consisting of lands served from the West Walker River and its tributaries above Topaz Lake Intake Canal and consisting principally of Antelope Valley.

That for Divisions Nos. 1, 2, 3, 5, and 6 the irrigation season shall extend from the first day of March to the thirty-first day of October of each year.

That for Division No. A and that portion of Division No. 6 above the Coleville Eaging station the irrigation season shall extend from the first day of March to the fifteenth day of Septemberrof each year.

That for Divisions Nos. 1, 2, 3, and 5, the duty of water is 1.2 cubic feet per second of water for each 100 acres of land entitled to water thereunder.

That for Divisions Nos. 4 and 6, the duty of water is 1.6 cubic feet per second of water for each 100 acres of land entitled to water thereunder.

That the points of diversion of water from the river in each of the divisions are designated to be as follows:

Division No. 1.

Gaging stations shell be established at the points of entry into Bridgeport Valley on Virginis. Greek, Green Creek, Summers Creek, Robinson Greek above and below Twin Lakes, Buckeye Creek and Swauger Creek, and a daily record maintained as to the faulton during the irrigation season, and these stations shall be deemed to be the points of diversion for the Bridgeport Valley Division. The gaging stations shall be constructed at the expense of Division No. 4 users and maintained by the Board; provided however, efforts will be made to have the stations installed and maintained by the United States Geological Survey to the end that a cooperative sharing of most labor and supervision may be brought about.

Suitable records shall be daily maintained as to the inflow into Bridgeport lake
Reservoir through the use of daily/levels with due consideration being given to

the discharge through the Bridgeport Dam outlet, and daily evaporation losses.

Records of the current and previous users shall be used to determine the percontage of return flow applicable to the consumptive use of water in the area. The application of these percentages to the amounts of water decreed to the individuals at the point of diversion shall determine the year of priority to be served to such individuals.

At all time the rights of all users having equal priorities shall be serviced equally. If at any time measurements indicate that a user of water in any Division having a decreed right with a priority earlier than, or equal to, that of a user of water in Division 4, is not receiving his prior or equal right serviced to the extent of the water to which he is entitled, the Water Master, or his deputies, shall forthed release sufficient water from Division No. 4 users to service the prior rights of users in Divisions 1, 2 and 3, to the full extent of the priority or equality of such users in Divisions 1, 2 and 3.

The report of the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner of date the 10th day of August, 1953, setting out specifically the points at which screw lift headgates are to be installed is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

That pursuant to previous orders of this Board and in accordance with paragraph 14 of the Decree it is required that at all diversions in Divisions Nos. 2, 3, 5, and 6, there shall be established at the owners own expense a reliable, sufficient and easily operated lock regulating readgate and a measuring device of a type that meets with the approval of the Board of Water Commissioners. It has been held that Parshall Flumes, Calco Metergates or Rectangular Weirs are an approved type of measuring device and that all headgates must be equipped with screw type headgates for the regulation of the flow of water into the ditches.

Division No. 1 secures full decree rights through the discharge through the Yerington Weir and inflow from the drainage system of the Walker River Irrigation District. A gaging station at Parkers at the lower end of Mason Velley will measure the water for the Indian Service.

In determining the year of priority to be served to the individual decreed users under the Walker River Stream System, the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner shall apply the following formula.

He shall determine the total amount of water entering the Welker River Stream System through natural channels. He shall add to this accumulated total of natural flow water the amount of return flow he computes to be returning to the stream system through seepage, drain canals or any other sources. The sum total of water from these two sources shall be considered to be the total amount of water available to serve the vested rights under the decree and the year of priority to be served shall be determined daily by the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner from this information. If at any time the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner determines that there is more water available in the stream than is required to fill the rights of all of the vested users including the rights of the Walker River Irrigation District and others similarly situated to store water, then he shall provate such excess water to all users in proportion to the rights already stablished.

If at any time the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner through investigation determine that any users' water is not being put to beneficial use, but is going to waste, he shall immediately refuse delivery of water to the said user, unless and until he is satisfied

that the water when returned to the user will be put to beneficial use within the meaning of the Decree.

The organizational structure of the Soard of U. S. Water Commissioners shall be as follows:

At the first meeting of the Board after the appointment of its members by the United States District Judge for the District of Neveda, they shall proceed to elect a Chairman, a Vice-Chairman, a Treasurer and a Secretary-Hanager.

The Chairman shall be the presiding officer at all meetings of the Board and have a vote in all proceedings. He shall appoint such committees as are descret necessary for the proper functioning of the Board.

The Vice-Chairman shall act in the absence of the Chairman, and shall be Chairman of the Finance Committee,

The Treasurer shall act as the fiscal officer of the Board.

The Secretary-Manager who need not be a Board member, shall be elected by the members of the Board and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board. He shall be the Executive officer of the Board, with authority by and with the approval of the Board to employ such persons as is deemed necessary to properly enforce the terms of the Decrse and bring about an equitable distribution of the waters of the Walker River Stre System. He shall at the spring meeting of the Board, present a plan of distribution for the forthcoming season, an estimate of the number of employees necessary, and the estimated costs thereof, together with a budget and proposed rate of assessment for the ensuing year. His report shall be considered by the Board and shall be accepted or rejected in whole or in part as the members of the Abard deem advisable. He shall after the budget and rate of assessment have been approved, assess all users at the same rate per acre within the system and shall proceed to collect such assessments for the use of the Board.

The Sacretary-Manager shall also be charged with the responsibility of accumulating and keeping the records, materials and property of the Board and shall be the custodian thereof.

The field distribution of the waters of the stream system shell be under the supervision of the Chief Deputy Water Commissioner who shall supervise the Deputy Water Commissioners, but who shall be responsible to the Secretary-Manager of the Board.

The Chairman, Treasurer, Chairman of the Finance Committee and the Escretary,

shall have the authority and they shall be responsible for the monthly approval and payment of the bills and accounts of the Board and they are herewith authorized to sign the warrants therefor at monthly meetings.

The Board shall refer all legal matters to the Boards attorney, heretofore appointed directly by the Court.

The Board shall meet semi-annually and at such other times as deemed proper by the Chairman of the Board and shall at these meetings either regular or special shall consider among any other matters that may properly come before them and which they consider matters within the jurisdiction of the Board, the payment of the bills by the Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary and shall approve or reject the action of these officers at that time.

These rules and regulations subject to the approval of the Court may be amended or changed by a majority of the Board.

This report shows that 18 control devices will be the minimum that may be installed to control the diversions in Bridgeport Valley. It might be necessary in the future to install 2 or 3 more screw gates.

No devices are shown as necessary on the small creeks as they seldom furnish enough water to fill the decree alloted to them. However, should there be any question among the Bridgeport users as to the distribution of water among themselves it may be necessary to require lock headgates at selected sites.
