Treated Waste Water Change Petition WW-1

ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN THE PLACE OF USE FOR TREATED WASTE WATER

WHEREAS;

- 1. Treated Waste Water change petition WW-1 was filed by U.S. March Air Force Base (March AFB) on April 3, 1985 pursuant to California Water Code, Sections 1210 and 1211.
- 2. The March AFB petitioned change was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board to obtain Board approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to expand the place of use of treated waste water.
- 3. The Board has determined that good cause for the petitioned change has been shown.
- 4. The Board has also determined that the petitioned change does not constitute the initiation of a new right, nor will it operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. Change petition WW-1, filed by March AFB on April 3, 1985, is hereby approved and the new place of use shall be as follows:

An Area of 840 acres which includes the Riverside National Cemetery and adjacent golf course and is located within Sections 26, and 27, T3S, R4W, SBB&M, as shown on map on file with the State Water Resources Control Board.
