ORDER

Treated Waste Water Change Petition WW-3

ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN THE
POINT OF DISCHARGE, PLACE OF USE AND
PURPOSE OF USE FOR TREATED WASTE WATER


WHEREAS:

1. Treated Waste Water change petition WW-3 was filed by Ramona Municipal Water District on August 10, 1989, pursuant to Sections 1210 and 1211 of the California Water Code.
2. The change petition was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (Board) to obtain Board approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to change the Point of Discharge, Place of Use and Purpose of Use.
3. The Board had determined that good cause for the changes has been shown.
4. The Board has determined that the changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Point of Discharge shall be at Santa Maria Waste Treatment Plant within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of projected Section 20, T13S, R1E, SBB&M.
2. Place of Use shall be in the Highland Valley within projected Sections 4, 5, 8, 9, 10, 15, 16, 17, 20, 21, 22, 27, 28 and 29, T13S, R1W, SBB&M, as shown on map on file with the Board.
3. Purpose of Use shall be Irrigation.
