ORDER

Treated Waste Water Change Petition WW-4

ORDER APPROVING CHANGE IN POINT OF DISCHARGE,
PLACE OF USE AND PURPOSE OF USE FOR TREATED WASTE WATER

WHEREAS:

1. Treated Waste Water change petition WW-4 was filed by the Desert Water Company on September 14, 1989, pursuant to Sections 1210 and 1211 of the California Water Code.
2. The change petition was filed with the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) to obtain Board approval under Sections 1211 and 1700 of the California Water Code to change the Point of Discharge, Place of Use, and Purpose of Use.
3. The SWRCB has determined that good cause for the changes has been shown.
4. The SWRCB has determined that the changes do not constitute the initiation of a new right nor operate to the injury of any other lawful user of water.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED THAT:

1. The Point of Discharge and source of reclaimed water shall be the Desert Water Agency Water Reclamation Plant within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 20, T4S, R5E, SBB&M. (0000001)

2. The Purpose of Use shall be for Irrigation and Industrial. (0000002)
3. The Place of Use shall be in a portion of the City of Palm Springs and a portion of the Desert Water Agency service area as shown on a map filed with the SWRCB dated September 1983. (0000004)
