I would like you to advise me, on a practical level, how to recover my total costs.

Are there more than the following alternatives?

- 1. Direct payment by the State or Federal Agencies.
- 2. An immediate write off of 1980 capital costs.

There are increased operating costs for maintenance and the ever spiraling costs of energy that I have not as yet projected.

If action number 2 is the most practical please advise how the paperwork should be handeled so that it will survive the IRS audit.
