Dear George:

I have on this date finished construction of the pump and platform, USA Permit #7020.

I am shocked at the total costs of this project. I have invoices for \$37,227.15 on this project. In addition I have put men and equipment and parts which would be worth at least \$3000.00 into the completion of this station.

I would like you to advise me, on a practical level, how to recover my total costs.

Are there more than the following alternatives?

1. Direct payment by the State or Federal Agencies.
2. An immediate write off of 1980 capital costs.

There are increased operating costs for maintenance and the ever spiraling costs of energy that I have not as yet projected.

If action number 2 is the most practical please advise how the paperwork should be handled so that it will survive the IRS audit.
