I led PCL's successful sponsorship of State legislation that doubled the flood protection requirements for new developments in California. I led PCL's participation in the SWRCB proceeding that resulted in the revocation of water rights for the proposed Auburn Dam. I led PCL's efforts that removed the unsafe and obsolete San Clemente Dam. I am a party in the SWRCB's Cease and Desist Order proceeding to eliminate illegal diversions from the Carmel River.

As a result over a billion dollars of water supply and ecosystem restoration projects have been constructed.
