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15	PROFESSIONAL BACKGROUND AND QUALIFICATIONS
16	1. I am a registered civil engineer in the State of California. I specialize in the areas
	of hydrology, hydraulics, water supply, water rights, irrigation project feasibility, and related
17	issues. I am a principal at MBK Engineers, located at 455 University Avenue, Suite 100,
18	Sacramento, CA 95825. MBK Engineers specializes in water resources engineering and performs
19	these engineering services for local public agencies and private clients, principally in the Delta
20	and the Sacramento Valley. MBK Engineers was formed in 1967 (then known as Murray, Burns
21	and Kienlen) and currently employs 21 engineers. Exhibit NDWA-4, which was previously
22	admitted into testimony, is a true and correct copy of my professional qualifications.
23	2. Exhibit NDWA-3 is a true and correct copy of my written testimony in this
24	proceeding, which was previously admitted into evidence. On October 28, 2016 I provided oral
25	testimony in support of the case in chief of North Delta Water Agency ("NDWA") and its
26	member districts.
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MBK Engineers and its predecessors have represented NDWA since its formation

1	in 1973 and also represented NDWA's predecessor organizations. My father Donald Kienlen,
2	former Principal of Murray, Burns and Kienlen, participated extensively in the negotiations of the
3	Contract between the State of California, Department of Water Resources and North Delta Water
4	Agency for the Assurance of a Dependable Water Supply of Suitable Quality ("1981 Contract")
5	(Exhibit DWR-306). Since the commencement of my employment with MBK Engineers in 1988,
6	I have been involved with monitoring water quality, contract compliance, and related issues for
7	NDWA. Since 1999, I have served as engineer for NDWA.
8	4. I have reviewed the testimony submitted by Petitioners in support of the case-in-
9	chief in this proceeding, together with the supporting exhibits. I have also reviewed the testimony
10	of my colleague, Gomathishankar Parvathinathan, and concur in that testimony.
11	5. While I am not a modeler, I concur with Dr. Parvathinathan's conclusion that
12	additional analysis can and should be undertaken by Petitioners to understand the full extent of
13	water supply impacts associated with meeting D-1641 water quality objectives with the WaterFix
14	project in operation.
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
