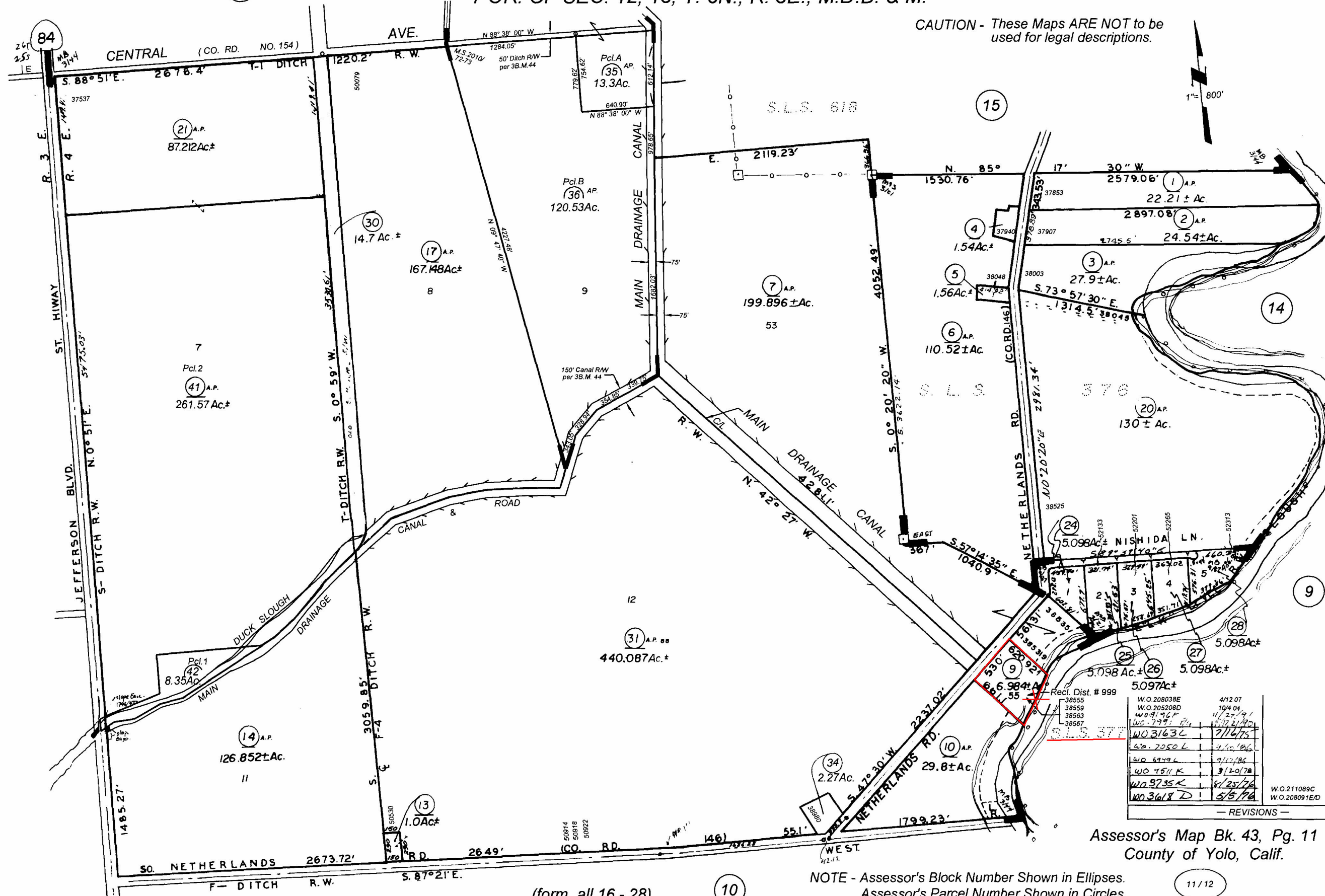
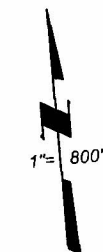

SACRAMENTO, Seventeenth day of March 1860.

It appearing from the Certificate of the State Treasurer, bearing date the Seventh day of January A. D. 1860, that Francis Delouchamp has paid to the State of California, the sum of Thirty-three and 06/100 Dollars, being 20 per cent. of the purchase money and first year's interest on the balance for 118.24/100

Acres of Swamp and Overflowed Land, described as follows, in SURVEY No. 377, Yolo COUNTY:

Fraction in the South East quarter of Section Eight (8) and fraction in the South West quarter of Section Nine (9) and frac in North East 1/4 of Sec 17 in TOWNSHIP No. 6 North RANGE No. 4 East Mount Diablo MERIDIAN.

Now, Therefore, be it Known, THAT the said Francis Delouchamp having made payment of said 20 per cent. and first year's interest for the above described tract of Land, under the provisions of an Act entitled "An Act amendatory of an Act entitled an Act to provide for the Sale and Reclamation of the Swamp and Overflowed Lands of this State, passed April 21st, 1858," approved April 18th, 1859, is the Purchaser of the same; and after having in all other respects complied with the provisions of said Act, and on presentation of this Certificate to the Governor of the State of California, and after the said Lands have been confirmed to the State, the said Francis Delouchamp, or his assigns, shall be entitled to receive a Patent for the same.

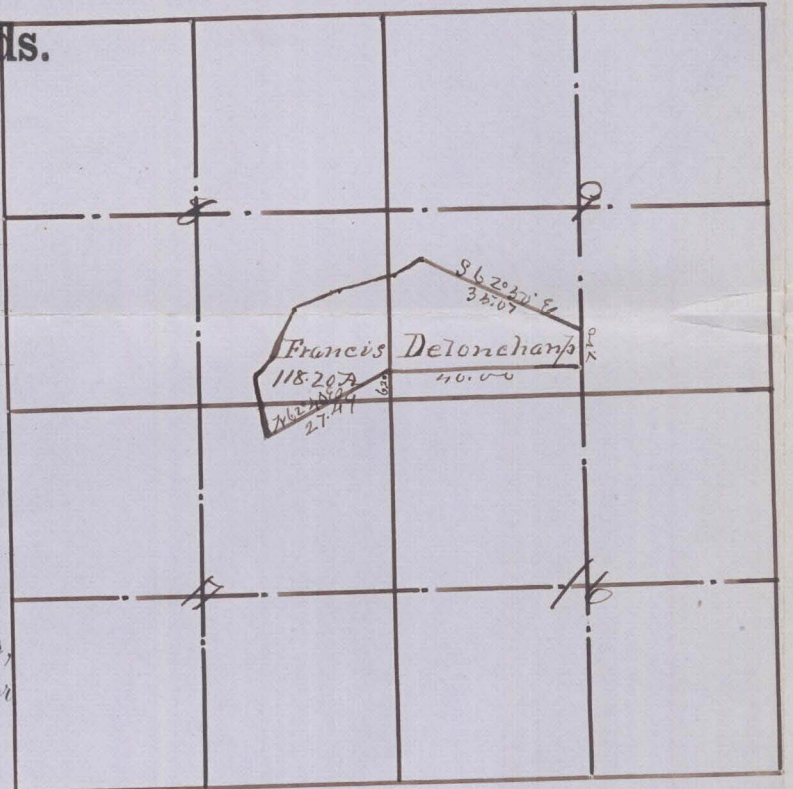

Francis Delonchamp of the State of California, County of Yolo,
 being duly sworn, deposes and says: that *he is a citizen of the*
United States That he wishes to purchase under the provisions
 of an Act to provide for the sale and reclamation of the Swamp and Overflowed Lands of this
 State, approved April 21st, 1858, a certain tract of Swamp and Overflowed Land in said County
 lying and situate *about 30 miles below Washington*
bounded on the North by King on the East by
the Daley on the South by McFadden &
on the West by Ocean containing
about 120.5 acres

And that he has not entered any other land under the provisions of this act, or under the prov-
 isions of an act passed April 28th, 1855, entitled an act to provide for the sale of the swamp and
 overflowed lands belonging to this State, which, with the land sought to be purchased, shall ex-
 ceed six hundred and forty acres; and that he does not know of any legal or equitable claim,
 other than his own, to the said land, and that to the best of his knowledge and belief said tract
 was overflowed during the year 1850, and that, judging from the indications of overflow, and the
 statements of others, that every forty acre lot, or its equivalent legal subdivision' embraced in
 said survey, was the greater part swamp or swampy, or subject to inundation at the planting,
 growing or harvesting season, so as to endanger, injure or destroy the crops, taking the average
 season for a reasonable number of years prior to 1850.

 of the County of Yolo, being duly sworn, do depose and say, that we are well acquainted with
 the method of surveying and marking the public lands, and that we have made, in our proper
 persons, examination of the lands described in the accompanying field notes and plat, and that
 from said examination we have discovered and are well satisfied that every forty acre lot, or its
 equivalent legal subdevison, embraced in said survey, is the greater part swamp or swampy, or
 subject to inundation at the planting, growing or harvesting season, so as to endanger, injure or
 destroy the crops, taking the average season for a reasonable number of years, as the rule of
 determination.
