10	THIS CONTRACT, made this <u>28th</u> day of <u>February</u> , 2014,
11	in pursuance generally of the Act of June 17, 1902 (32 Stat. 388), and acts amendatory or
12	supplementary thereto, including, but not limited to, the acts of August 26, 1937 (50 Stat. 844),
13	as amended and supplemented, August 4, 1939 (53 Stat. 1187), as amended and supplemented, ,
14	June 21, 1963 (77 Stat. 68), October 12, 1982 (96 Stat. 1263), October 27, 1986 (100 Stat. 3050)
15	as amended, and Title XXXIV of the Act of October 30, 1992 (106 Stat. 4706), all collectively
16	hereinafter referred to as Federal Reclamation law, between the UNITED STATES OF
17	AMERICA, hereinafter referred to as the United States, and PLACER COUNTY WATER
18	AGENCY, hereinafter referred to as the Contractor, a public agency of the State of California,
19	duly organized, existing, and acting pursuant to the laws thereof;
20	WITNESSETH, That:
21	EXPLANATORY RECITALS
22	WHEREAS, the United States and the Contractor entered into the interim
23	renewal contract identified as Contract No. 14-06-200-5082A-IR1, hereinafter referred to as
24	IR1, which provided for the continued water service to the Contractor effective from
25	January 1, 2012, through February 28, 2014; and

26	WHEREAS, the United States and the Contractor have made significant progress
27	in their negotiations of a long-term renewal contract, believe that further negotiations on the
28	long-term renewal contract would be beneficial, and mutually commit to continue to negotiate to
29	seek to reach agreement, but anticipate that the environmental documentation necessary for
30	execution of any long-term renewal contract may be delayed for reasons beyond the control of
31	the parties; and
32	WHEREAS, the Contractor has requested a subsequent interim renewal contract
33	pursuant to Article 2 of IR1; and
34	WHEREAS, the United States has determined that the Contractor has to date
35	fulfilled all of its obligations under IR1; and
36	WHEREAS, the United States is willing to renew IR1 pursuant to the terms and
37	conditions set forth below;
38	NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual and dependent covenants
39	herein contained, it is hereby mutually agreed by the parties hereto as follows:
40 41	RENEWAL AND REVISION OF CONTRACT NO. 14-06-200-5082A-IR1
42	1. Except as specifically modified by this contract, all provisions of IR1 are renewed
43	with the same force and effect as if they were included in full text with the exception of Article 2
44	of IR1 thereof, which is revised as follows:
45	(a) The first sentence in subdivision (a) of Article 2 of IR1 is modified as
46	follows: "This Contract shall be effective from March 1, 2014, and shall remain in effect
47	through February 29, 2016, and thereafter will be renewed as described in Article 2 of IR1 if a
48	long-term renewal contract has not been executed with an effective commencement date of
49	March 1, 2016."

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50	(b) Subdivision (b) of Article 2 of IR1 is amended by deleting the date
51	"February 28, 2014," and replacing same with the date "February 29, 2016."

RESOLUTION NO. 14- 05 OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE PLACER COUNTY WATER AGENCY APPROVING AN INTERIM RENEWAL CONTRACT WITH UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF THE INTERIOR BUREAU OF RECLAMATION FOR CENTRAL VALLEY PROJECT WATER SERVICE FROM THE AMERICAN RIVER DIVISION AND AUTHORIZING ITS EXECUTION

WHEREAS, in 2001, the Agency entered into an Amendatory water service contract with the United States for water from the federal Central Valley Project ("CVP") that provided for deliveries of CVP water until December 31, 2011 with option for renewal for an additional 25 years; and

WHEREAS, in August, 2002, the Agency and United States executed an Amendment to the Amendatory Contract that did not change the term of that Contract; and

WHEREAS, the term of the current Amendatory Contract as amended ends on February 28, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the United States is precluded from entering into a Long-Term Renewal Contract with the Agency at this time due to challenges to the environmental documentation necessary to execute such a Contract; and

WHEREAS, the Agency has requested an Interim Renewal Contract pursuant to Section 3404(c)(1) of the CVPIA and;

WHEREAS, the terms of the Interim Renewal Contract do not provide for any change in the terms and conditions of the Amendatory Contract as amended, but provide a contractual basis for continued deliveries of Central Valley Project water through February 29, 2016; and

WHEREAS, PCWA's only diversion of CVP water has been from Folsom Reservoir and such diversions will not change within the term of the Interim Contract; NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

The Board hereby finds and determines that the foregoing recitals are true and correct.

1. The Board hereby finds that the Agency's diversions under the Interim Contract will have no potential for any significant adverse effect on the physical environment
