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## Chapter 30 Growth Inducement

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3 The assessment of direct and indirect growth inducement potential of the proposed project is based  
4 on changes in operations that would result from implementing the approved project. Because  
5 operation of the proposed project would be identical to operation of the approved project, there  
6 would be no incremental impacts on growth inducement potential attributable to modifying the  
7 footprint of the water conveyance facilities. Consequently, there would be no changes in the  
8 conclusions presented in the analysis of growth inducement impacts for the approved project  
9 (Alternative 4A). These impacts are fully disclosed in Final EIR/EIS Chapter 30, *Growth Inducement*.
