Chapter 30 **Growth Inducement**

The assessment of direct and indirect growth inducement potential of the proposed project is based on changes in operations that would result from implementing the approved project. Because operation of the proposed project would be identical to operation of the approved project, there would be no incremental impacts on growth inducement potential attributable to modifying the footprint of the water conveyance facilities. Consequently, there would be no changes in the conclusions presented in the analysis of growth inducement impacts for the approved project (Alternative 4A). These impacts are fully disclosed in Final EIR/EIS Chapter 30, *Growth Inducement*.
