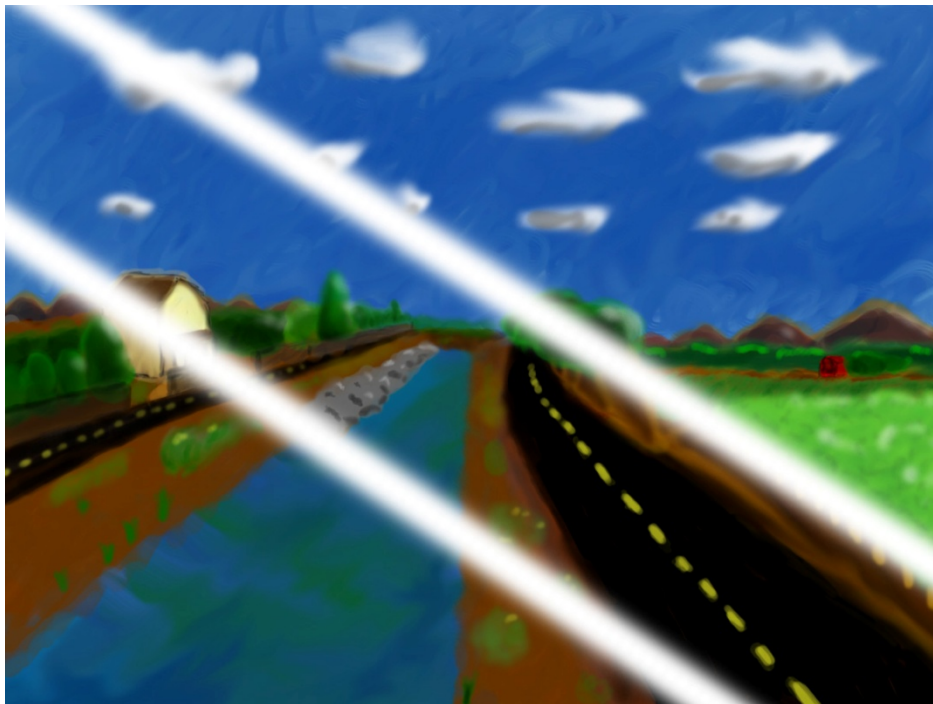

I am a young millennial who grew up on the banks of the Sacramento River in an almost 100-year old family home—directly across from one of the proposed intakes south of Clarksburg.

Even the EIR/EIS reports that vibrations from the pile driving alone can cause the collapse of vulnerable buildings; also feared would be damage to the levees themselves.

Structures, farms, homes, wells, roads, and over 150 years of local history in small heritage towns could be sacrificed and, in some instances, erased.
