POLICY STATEMENT/LETTER – AGAINST THE CALIFORNIA WATERFIX – 3
PROPOSED NEW INTAKES ON THE SACRAMENTO RIVER

I live in Clarksburg which is slightly North of where the 3 new water intakes are planned to be installed. I am very concerned about the negative impact these intakes would have on my community and certainly the entire Delta Region.

My home and the entire Clarksburg Community depends on the aquifers for their domestic water. In times of drought, we frequently pump sand and the dewatering effect of 3 new intakes from the Sacramento River could be catastrophic on our water supply.

My major concern is, of course, my water supply but the negative impact these intakes would have on the local roads and the levee damage from heavy trucks, the loss of farm income, the noise and vibration damage from pile driving and the possible destruction of some of the historic buildings due to the pile driving cannot be overlooked. It could be devastating.

I request that the 3 intakes not be authorized.
