

Appendix C

Supplemental Special-Status Species Lists for Plants and Wildlife

This appendix provides lists of special-status plant and wildlife species to supplement information presented in Section 7.6.1, *Terrestrial Biological Resources*. The lists of special-status species were generated based on information obtained from: (1) a list generated by querying the California Natural Diversity Database (CNDDDB) for species that have been reported in the counties within the study area (^CDFW 2021) and (2) a list of species that have a potential to occur within the study area as identified by the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service’s (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation website (^USFWS 2021). The species status listings were reviewed and updated according to the *State and Federally Listed Endangered, Threatened, and Rare Plants of California* (^CDFW 2023a), *Special Vascular Plants, Bryophytes, and Lichens List* (^CDFW 2023b), *State and Federally Listed Endangered and Threatened Animals of California* (^CDFW 2023c), and *Special Animals List* (^CDFW 2023d).

C.1 Special-Status Plant Species

Table C.1-1 supplements the special-status plant species information presented in Section 7.6.1, *Terrestrial Biological Resources*, (see Table 7.6.1-2 in Section 7.6.1.2, *Environmental Setting*), and provides an environmental setting context for actions evaluated in Section 7.21, *Habitat Restoration and Other Ecosystem Projects*, Section 7.22, *New or Modified Facilities*, and Chapter 9, *Proposed Voluntary Agreements*. Special-status plant species that occur in wetland, riparian, or aquatic habitats hydrologically connected to rivers and streams in the study area are identified in Table 7.6.1-2 and excluded from Table C.1-1. Table C.1-1 lists all other special-status plant species known to occur or that have potential to occur in the study area, including species that occur in vernal pools or isolated wetlands.

C.2 Special-Status Wildlife Species

Table C.2-1 supplements the special-status wildlife species information presented in Section 7.6.1, *Terrestrial Biological Resources*, (see Table 7.6.1-3 in Section 7.6.1.2, *Environmental Setting*), and provides an environmental setting context for actions evaluated in Section 7.21, *Habitat Restoration and Other Ecosystem Projects*, Section 7.22, *New or Modified Facilities*, and Chapter 9, *Proposed Voluntary Agreements*. Special-status wildlife species that occur in wetland, riparian, or aquatic

habitats hydrologically connected to rivers and streams in the study area are identified in Table 7.6.1-3 and excluded from Table C.2-1. Table 7.6.1-3 does not list fish or vernal pool branchiopods (see Section 7.6.1, *Terrestrial Biological Species*). Table C.2-1 lists all other special-status wildlife species known to occur or that have potential to occur in the study area, including species that occur in vernal pools or isolated wetlands. Table 7.6.2-1 in Section 7.6.2, *Aquatic Biological Species*, identifies special-status fish species that occur in the study area.
