# NOTICE OF WORKSHOP ON THE WATER MEASUREMENT AND REPORTING REGULATION ADOPTED PURSUANT TO 2015 SENATE BILL 88

Division of Water Rights staff from the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board) will hold a workshop to discuss recently released datafile templates and guidance for the water measurement and reporting regulation adopted pursuant to 2015 Senate Bill 88 (SB 88). During the workshop, there will be a staff presentation about the regulation and instructions on how to find, download, and use the datafile templates. The public can ask questions and engage with staff following the presentation. The workshop will be recorded and posted online.

## **BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE**

California's recent droughts have highlighted the need for high-quality water diversion data. Codified in the California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 931 through 938, SB 88 requires that certain diverters measure and report their diversion volumes to the State Water Board.

Board staff have evaluated ways to clarify the measurement requirements and improve reported data quality. Staff have developed and released a series of datafile templates to simplify the reporting process. While use of the templates is voluntary, there is significant opportunity to reduce unintentional reporting errors when submitting data in

the template formats. Additional guidance materials including (1) updated website text and formatting, (2) a frequently asked questions list, (3) a step-by-step guide describing how to navigate the regulation and measure diversions, and (4) a video tutorial for the datafile templates are scheduled to be released before the annual reporting deadline. The purpose of this workshop is to review the water measurement and reporting regulation and its requirements, demonstrate how to use the new guidance materials, and answer any remaining questions.
