I'm writing to strongly encourage you to reverse the State Water Resources Control Board's decision to relax the D-1641 March requirement for inflows to the San Francisco Bay. These flows are critical to the existence of crucial biodiversity. I also hope you reverse the decision to partly relax the D-1641 limits on export pumping, in order to prevent devastating impacts on the last remaining Delta smelt and winter-run salmon. We only have a few more weeks to save the species. **D-1641 is reversible, extinction is not.**
