As a California resident and someone who has dedicated my studies, career, and recreational time to the sustainability of our beautiful + unique ecosystem, I wanted to share how important it is to meet the co-equal goals of ecosystem protection and water supply in the Bay Delta Water Quality Control Plan.

60% of unimpaired flow does not seem sufficient in the San Joaquin River, given the high dependence on greater flows by native fish, wildlife, drinking water etc. Rather than implement this cut, water efficiency in terms of irrigation practices, crop choice & better management of snowmelt, we can find balance between these goals.
