Hello Mr. Satkowski,

I would like to ask you to have the State Water Board reconsider its decisions to

1. Relax the D-1641 March requirements for inflows to San Francisco Bay. It is important to ensure that these flows critical to the continued existence of Delta smelt, winter-run Chinook salmon and other species are actually provided.
2. Partly relax the D-1641 limits on export pumping. This would prevent devastating impacts on the last remaining Delta smelt and winter-run salmon.

Preservation of these fish species is important in the long-term for the overall health of the San Francisco Bay/ San Joaquin Delta ecosystem and for California's economy.
