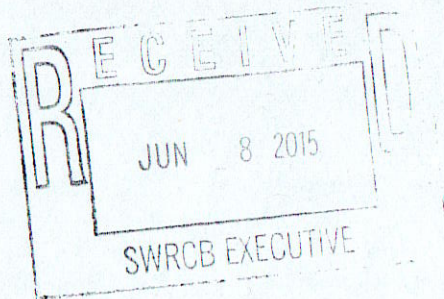


Chair Felicia Marcus & Board

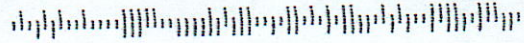
