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The Groundwater Replenishment System (GWRS)

- New 70-MGD advanced water purification facility
- Takes treated sewer water that otherwise would be wasted to the ocean, purifies it to near distilled quality and then recharges it into the groundwater basin
- **■** Operational since January 2008
- 30-MGD expansion under construction (March 2015)





	Plant Size	Plant Capital Cost	Low Interest State Loan	Percent
Initial Project	70 MGD	\$481 Million	\$135 Million	28%
Plant Expansion	<u>30 MGD</u>	\$142 Million	\$141 Million	99%
Total	100 MGD	\$623 Million	\$276 Million	44%




Replenishment Assessment History






OCWD Service Territory Water Supply Sources (afy)





Proposed Huntington Beach Poseidon Resources Ocean Desalination Project

- New 50-MGD ocean desalination plant
- Reduce need for imported water
- Capital Cost \$670 million
- OCWD considering partnership with Poseidon to develop the plant
- Private activity bonds being used to fund ~82% of project – greater than 5.5% interest rate
- **■** Expensive project \$1,850/af
- Cheaper capital would help lower cost
