WITHDRAWAL OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY COMPLAINT FOR FAILURE TO FULFILL OBLIGATIONS UNDER STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD ORDER WR 2015-0026-DWR

On December 15, 2015, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division), issued an Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint to Jeremy & Leslie Gross for failure to fulfill obligations under State Water Board Order WR 2015-0026-DWR¹.

Landowner records were based on the best available information, as provided by the Sonoma County Clerk-Recorder-Assessor's Office. Since no communication was received prior to December 15, 2015, the Division believed Jeremy & Leslie Gross to be the owner of parcel number(s) 110-260-062-000.

United States Postal Service records show that the ACL Complaint was delivered on January 5, 2016. Since no communication was received following delivery of the ACL Complaint, Division staff reassessed updated property records and determined that the property was sold prior to when Order WR 2015-0026-DWR took effect. Based on review of the additional information, the Division withdraws the ACL Complaint.
