WITHDRAWAL OF ADMINISTRATIVE CIVIL LIABILITY COMPLAINT FOR FAILURE TO FULFILL OBLIGATIONS UNDER STATE WATER RESOURCES CONTROL BOARD ORDER WR 2015-0026-DWR

On December 15, 2015, the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Water Rights (Division), issued an Administrative Civil Liability (ACL) Complaint to GOOD EARTH PROPERTIES LLC for failure to fulfill obligations under State Water Board Order WR 2015-0026-DWR¹.

Landowner mailing addresses were based on the best available information, as provided by the Sonoma County Clerk-Recorder-Assessor's Office. Since no communication was received prior to December 15, 2015, the Division believed 411 MATHESON ST to be the mailing address for 061-200-018-000.

The ACL Complaint was not delivered to GOOD EARTH PROPERTIES LLC and was returned to the State Water Board on January 16, 2016. The information required by Order WR 2015-0026-DWR was submitted for parcel numbers 061-200-018-000 on December 21, 2015. Based on this information, the Division withdraws the ACL Complaint.
