PURPOSE OF HEARING

The purpose of this hearing is for the State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board or Board): 1) to receive evidence relevant to determining whether Stone House Ranch Properties (Respondent) violated regulations or the terms or conditions of any permit or license requiring the filing of a Progress Report by Permittee or Report of Licensee (collectively, Annual Water Use Report); and 2) if a violation occurred, to determine the amount of administrative civil liability and adopt an order imposing administrative civil liability upon the Respondent. Specific allegations related to the alleged violation are set forth in the administrative civil liability complaints (ACL Complaints).

BACKGROUND

For the 2016 and 2017 calendar years, California Code of Regulations, title 23, sections 925 and 929 require permittees and licensees, respectively, to submit Annual Water Use Reports no later than April 1 of the following year. (Cal. Code Regs., tit. 23, §§ 925, subd. (b); 929, subd. (b); see also Wat. Code, §§ 1840–1841.) These reports must be filed electronically using the Report Management System—a component of the Electronic Water Right Information Management System.
